## **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1114, as introduced, provides increases to the minimum salary schedule for teachers in public schools with an additional \$1,000 for the 2017-18 school year, an additional \$2,000 for the 2018-19 school year, and an additional \$3,000 beginning with the 2019-20 school year. Department of Education personnel provide calculation information based on the statutory definition of teacher under 70-1-116. The number of teachers included in the calculation is 44,954.
