Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 1122 provides that the Legislature preempts the entire field of legislation in this state touching in any way the prosecution of offenses relating to the possession of controlled dangerous substances, except marijuana, to the complete exclusion of any order, ordinance, local legislation or regulation by any municipality or other political subdivision of this state. The preemption does not apply to prosecutions in municipal courts of record for offenses relating to possession of a controlled dangerous substance.
