**Research Analysis**

- Col Noble A. Miller, USAF – WWII, Korea and Vietnam Memorial Highway;
- SSG Jack Morgan Memorial Bridge;
- Lt. Lowry Douglas Durlington Memorial Highway;
- SPC Sonny Gene Sampler Memorial Highway;
- Officer Nathan B. Graves Memorial Highway;
- RM3 Bill Lester Driver, US Navy, Memorial Bridge;
- HM3 (FMF) Eric “Doc” Warren Memorial Highway;
