**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1152, which relaxes the language by which the Insurance Commissioner is allowed to select a plan administrator for the Oklahoma Temporary Motorist Liability Plan, could result in the sheriffs not being selected. As the sheriffs do take in some revenue from their participation as plan administrator, there is the possibility of a loss of revenue for the sheriffs. This is dependent upon what the Insurance Commissioner decides.
