**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 1163 clarifies the definition of top salary for members of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System who retire with a service related disability. The measure would authorize those members to have their retirement benefit determined using the greater of the final average salary or top pay amount.
