**Research Analysis**

HB 1169 creates four classes of amusement devices: permanent, temporary, inflatable, and “other.” The measure gives the Commissioner of Labor authority to determine the date and frequency of required inspections, depending on the type of ride, but provides that no permanent or temporary amusement device may operate without an initial inspection.
