The measure modifies the Oklahoma Teachers' Retirement system by creating an optional defined contribution system for members who join on or after July 1, 2018. The measure sets a minimum employee contribution of 4.5% with an employer match of 6%. Additionally, the member would receive an employer match of 7% if he or she contributes 7% or greater.
