The introduced measure extends the transferability of unused sick leave for teachers to the Oklahoma School for the Blind and the Oklahoma School for the Deaf beginning July 1, 2017.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1188, as introduced, relates to schools and unused sick leave. Language is added related to the Oklahoma School for the Blind or the Oklahoma School for the Deaf to allow for certain cumulative unused sick leave for an employed teacher in a school district to transfer to the Oklahoma School for the Blind or the Oklahoma School for the Deaf where the teacher is employed the next succeeding year.

Further, if a teacher is employed at the Oklahoma School for the Blind or the Oklahoma School for the Deaf after July 1, 2017, any unused sick leave up to 60 days that is accumulated at a school district prior to such date will be transferable. The measure will have no significant cost, but could have minimal costs to the Schools for the Blind and the Deaf with the Department of Rehabilitation Services.
