Fiscal Analysis

The CS to HB 1198 does not alter the original fiscal impact below: HB 1198 as introduced directs the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs to develop and maintain a state-wide veteran's registry. ODVA in consultation with OMES has estimated the built cost to be around \$25,000 (as of 4/7/2017) and yearly maintenance of the application to be \$6,055. Regarding access to the database, it is not yet known if DPS and/ or the Wildlife Commission could access the secured website without expense, but it is anticipated that they will be able to do so without incurring costs.

This registry would be in tandem with or the same as the registry outlined in SB456. Two bills = one registry and one fiscal impact.
