**Research Analysis**

The CS deletes the requirement for including copies of all credit card statements, identified by the department responsible for each credit card, in the database established in the School District Transparency Act.

The measure modifies the calculation of per-pupil expenditure as it relates to the School District Transparency Act by specifying that the figure is to be derived by dividing total current expenditures by the total number of students enrolled for each school year.
