**Research Analysis**

HB 1203 allows certified driver education instructors to administer the Class D driving skills portion of the Oklahoma driver examination to person who has not previously been a student of the instructor but has completed the eyesight examination and who has been issued a learner permit. The measure requires the Department of Public Safety to maintain a list of certified designated examiners with contact information on the Department's website. Every driver license exam site is required to display a list of certified designated examiners in the same county as the exam site.
