**Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 1228 requires DHS to notify certain licensed child-placing agencies when a child in the department's custody becomes eligible for adoption, and needs a permanent placement, in order to locate a possible prospective adoptive parent for the child. The measure also authorizes the department to reimburse the child-placing agency for expenses incurred in locating an adoptive parent for the child.
