Research Analysis

HB1234, as introduced, creates the Court Records Protection and Modernization Act. Current law imposes time limitations on the minimal number of years that papers records must be physically stored. The measure would allow court officials and personnel to bypass the maintenance periods and allow records to be destroyed as long as a copy has been electronically reproduced on microfilm, optical disk or any other media allowed for by the Oklahoma Supreme Court rules.
