## **Research Analysis**

The Senate amendments to HB 1259 requires a person who is seeking election to sheriff to have served as a certified peace officer, in a full-time capacity, for at least 4 years prior to filing for the office. The measure defines "peace officer" to mean a fulltime duly appointed or elected officer who is paid for working more than twenty-five (25) hours per week enforcing state, federal or military laws and local ordinances of this state.
