Research Analysis

HB 1281 creates the Oklahoma Construction Registry Act. The measure creates a Construction Registry, and gives an owner or general contractor the option to register a project with the registry. Any registration must occur within 10 business days after the contract signing date or start of construction, whichever occurs first. Once a project is registered, all providers (including materials, labor, service, or rental equipment) on the project must register as well. A provider may register at any time during the project, and is only required to register once per project. Any provider not registering loses all rights to file a lien or collect on a bond. The measure provides a schedule of fees for use of the Construction Registry, and the proceeds from those fees are to be used to implement and maintain the registry.

Fiscal Analysis

According to officials with the Secretary of State, one-time costs related to database development could range anywhere from \$17,224 to \$54,625 (see chart below). Additionally, depending on the volume of registrants, the agency anticipates the *potential* need for an Administrative Assistant position and office/equipment at a cost of approximately \$50,000 for salary + benefits and \$5,000 the equipment.

Costs to the agency could be offset by the collection of fee revenue; however, without a previous registrant history or data on potential registrants, the agency cannot estimate future fee revenue.
