The committee substitute authorizes a board of county commissioners to construct, improve, repair, or maintain any of the streets of a municipality with a population greater than 15,000 if the county determines such is necessary to promote or ensure public safety or encourage, or promote commerce.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure provides that certain population limitations regard county participation in constructing, improving, repairing or maintaining municipal streets will not apply if county commissioners determine such street activities are necessary. The subsection includes current provision related to the passage of a sales tax by a municipality that is earmarked for streets and roadways. The provision is permissive and any financial consideration will depend on specific county participation.
