**Research Analysis**

The measure authorizes a board of county commissioners to construct, improve, repair, or maintain the streets up a municipality having a population greater than 5,000. Current law provides this authorization for municipalities with a population between 5,000 and 15,000.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure removes a maximum population for municipalities related to a provision whereby counties may construct, improve, repair or maintain municipal street under certain circumstances. The removal of the 15,000 population maximum may result in municipalities with populations in excess of that number may include the respective county in their street programs, As the provision is permissive, no reliable indication of any cost sharing or other consideration can be completed.
