**Research Analysis**

HB 1302 provides that persons licensed by ABLE, who are licensed to operate in a facility or on property owned or operated by any agency, political subdivision or public trust of this state, may allow other licensees to operate on their licensed premises for events that are temporary in nature. In the event that multiple licensees are operating in a facility or on property owned or operated by any agency, political subdivision or public trust of this state, each licensee is responsible for violations occurring in their area designated to be their temporary licensed premises.
