**Research Analysis**

The measure authorizes the Department of Transportation and county governments to issue permits and to regulate the harvesting of hay along the right-of-way of highways. Permit fees will be credited to the respective State Highway Construction and Maintenance Fund and county highway fund.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Language regarding the issuance of permits to harvest hay is permissive; however, the measure stipulates that the Oklahoma Department of Transportation and the counties issuing such permits shall charge a permit fee to defray the costs of administration. The measure does not identify a specific amount.
