Research Analysis

The introduced measure would automatically enroll children, who meet special income provisions, in the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program. These children will not have to execute an agreement as a condition of their enrollment, and if they were denied participation in the program prior to the 2017-18 school year they will be allowed to participate if good cause is shown.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1307, as introduced, relates to the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program, and provides that specified students will be considered automatically enrolled and not be required to execute an agreement. Such students who were denied participation in the program prior to the 2017-18 school year will be allowed to participate if good cause is shown.

There will be a cost to the program dependent on how many of such students qualify and which public college or university they attend. State Regents Office personnel do not anticipate the additional costs to be significant.
