HB 1319 authorizes the state Board of Agriculture to promulgate rules governing all facilities involved in the production and distribution of milk, including the disposal of milk. The measure also makes it unlawful to willfully, recklessly, or negligently violate provisions of the Milk and Milk Products Act.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1319, as introduced, modifies authority to the Oklahoma State Board of Agriculture to promulgate rules concerning production, inspection and sanitary conditions for producing, transporting, processing and distributing milk and milk products; to meet the minimum standards of the US. Department of Health and Human Services and the recommended Grade A Pasteurized Milk Ordinance. Per the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture (ODAFF) this is part of the regulation expectation, and there is \$0 fiscal impact to the state.
