The conference committee substitute for HB1341 restricts access to date of birth records and directs the Oklahoma Supreme Court to develop an online registration and access portal to allow approved entities and persons to access date of birth records. The court is authorized to charge an annual fee up to \$1500 to offset the cost of creating the online access system.

Fiscal Analysis

The CCR A on HB 1341 requires the Supreme Court to develop an online registration and access portal for approved entities and persons to access certain records. The bill allows the Supreme Court to assess an annual fee of \$1,500 to offset the cost of implementation and upkeep of the system.

The Supreme Court estimates this fee will not cover the entirety of the costs for implementation.
