## **Research Analysis**

HB1341, as introduced, prohibits the following court documents from being viewable on the Internet if they contain complete personal identifier numbers in the case file:

- -arrest warrants;
- -bench warrants;
- -cost warrnats;
- -criminal informtionals;
- -wildlife tickets;
- -traffic tickets;
- -transcripts of criminal proceedings and exhibits; and
- -victim protective orders.

Information posted to the Oklahoma Court Information System, the National Crime Information Center, the Law Enforcement Enterprise Portal, the National Instant Criminal Background Check System or any other similar shared-data management concept between federal, state, local and tribal criminal justice agencies would be exempt from this restriction.
