**Research Analysis**

HB 1376 alters the definition of “public agency” within the Oklahoma Underground Facilities Damage Prevention Act by removing language that includes cities, towns, counties, subdivisions or other governmental entities. The measure also requires any person, rather than specifically the excavator, who causes damage to underground facilities to notify the facility operator.
