The Senate Amendment for HB 1388 eliminates the provision that would have provided protection against nuisance actions when there is a change in the type of agricultural or forestry production.

HB 1388 modifies state agriculture nuisance law to prevent frivolous or malicious lawsuits by adding protections for production breaks less than three years or changes in agricultural technology.
