HB 1389 caps the value of any contract for roofing repairs or replacement through the Roofing Asset Management Program (RAMP) or a successor program at \$25,000.

Fiscal Analysis

If roofing contracts in FY-18 approached the same number and contract amounts as those that occurred in 2016, the limitations put forth in the Committee Substitute to HB 1389 would impact state revenues as a result of the reduction in contracts and related fee revenue, which amounts to 3.5 percent of the job cost. According to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES), of the 59 projects that utilized the Roofing Asset Management Program (RAMP) in 2016, 33 of them were above \$25,000, and those 33 collected approximately \$219,000 in fees.
