**Fiscal Analysis**

SUBREC for HB 1402 provides, contingent of availability of funding, that beginning with the 2017-18 school year, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall establish a teacher shortage employment incentive program for all students who declare an intention to serve and teach in a secondary level public school for a minimum of seven years. The State Regents are authorized to make employment incentive payments to specified persons.
