**Fiscal Analysis**

The FA1 on HB 1406 revises sentences for crimes against the elderly and incapacitated. The amendment reverts sentences back to the original statutory language with provisions for those who commit the crimes more than once. This amendment could have an impact on DOC inmate population. However, the extent of the effect is contingent upon the number of people convicted and the length of sentence determined.
