## **Fiscal Analysis**

The measure authorizes the Joint Committee on Accountability to request the State Auditor and Inspector to conduct performance audits and authorizes the Committee to study the feasibility of privatizing certain assets. Costs associated with performance audits will depend on a number of variables, including the auditors' risk assessment, scope of the audit, and hourly rate(s) of the auditor(s) assigned to the task. Similarly, any feasibility studies will depend on the scope of the project and current administrative availability.
