**Research Analysis**

HB1427 creates the Out-of-State Tax Collections Enforcement Act of 2017 and allows the Oklahoma Tax Commission to establish an out-of-state tax collections enforcement division and employ private auditors or audit firms to pursue the collection of unpaid taxes owed to the state by a remote seller or out-of-state individuals, firms and corporations.
