HB 1428 allows a person 18 years of age who is a member, veteran or honorably discharged from the United States Armed Forces, the Reserves or National Guard to apply for a carry license.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1428, as introduced, allows those between the ages 18 and 21 who is or has been a member of the armed forces, to apply for a handgun license from the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation (OSBI). This may increase the number of licenses acquired per year which could have a slight revenue increase for OSBI. The exact amount of increase is dependent on the number of persons in this age category who apply.
