## **Research Analysis**

The measure authorizes county clerks to hire a general counsel. The measure also adds the following county clerk fees for counties with a population greater than 400,000:

\$15.00 for recording deeds of four pages or less; then \$2.00 per page thereafter; and \$40.00 for recording mortgages of twenty pages or less; then \$2.00 per page thereafter.
