**Fiscal Analysis**

CS for HB 1459 relates to the Lindsey Nicole Henry Scholarships for Students with Disabilities Program. The measure provides that a student who was adopted while in the permanent custody of the Department of Human Services will be exempt from certain requirements, but will be required to meet other eligibility requirements to participate. The measure has no fiscal impact.
