Research Analysis

The Conference Committee Substitute to HB 1465 prohibits the sharing of personal information or biometric data with the federal government directly, except as required by the REAL ID Act of 2005. Data may also be shared between agencies, boards, commissions or political subdivisions or as otherwise permitted by law. The measure provides that a child passenger being transported by a driver of a vehicle who has been issued a detachable placard indicating physical disability or a physically disabled license plate and valid letter of forward-facing exemption issued from the Department of Public Safety is permitted to transport a child under four (4) years of age in a forward-facing child passenger restraint system. The placard and forward-facing exemption letter must be present in the vehicle to be in compliance.
