**Fiscal Analysis**

FA1 on HB 1465 deletes sections 1-8 of the CS version of the bill. The remaining sections:

- Stipulate that personally identifiable information for non-compliant REAL ID licenses be stored separately from the REAL ID compliant licenses;
- Requires DPS to create and offer non-compliant license holders (except felons) a biometric data waiver;
- Gives DPS the ability to promulgate rules to enforce the measures in the bill.

The exact fiscal impact is difficult to calculate since DPS will have to develop new processes for implementing the requirements of the bill.
