**Research Analysis**

HB 1491, as introduced, modifies the Oklahoma Child Care Facilities Licensing Act by lowering the age of children, from 5 to 4, attending accredited summer youth camps that are exempt from licensure and increasing the number of hours per week, from 15 to 21, that exempt child care facilities can operate.
