The introduced measure requires the certifier of a death certificate who knows that a lethal drug, overdose, or other means of assisted suicide or suicide as defined in the Assisted Suicide Prevention Act, to include the information in the cause of death or conditions contributing to the cause of the death. Under the measure, failing to do so would be considered unprofessional conduct.
