**Fiscal Analysis**

The CS on HB 1499 has no initial fiscal impact on any of the three agencies involved. OBND and OSBI do operate aircraft but have already transferred ownership and control to DPS per Governor's Executive Order 2015-45. Agencies will incur some costs of paying DPS for aircraft usage on a mission basis per any MOU, but that cost will be offset for OBND and OSBI since they will no longer be responsible for the expenses of operating and maintaining an aircraft full-time. DPS is able to charge the agencies for use to absorb some maintenance costs.
