**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 1499 transfers all aircraft assets and law enforcement aircraft operations from the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control and the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to the Department of Public Safety. The measure allows effected agency directors to enter into intra-agency agreements with the Department of Public Safety for the use of aircraft assets and payment of hourly operational costs.

The measure repeals Title 63, Section 2-106.1 which relates to the OBNDD being authorized to lease a seaplane.
