Research Analysis

The measure transfers the authority for the Jenks Trojans license plate to a different section. Also, the measure also corrects a reference by changing the Oklahoma *Firefighters* Fallen and Living Memorial to the Oklahoma Fallen and Living *Firefighters* Memorial. Finally, the measure creates the Bixby Spartans license plate to be designed in consultation with the Bixby School District and authorizes the Oklahoma Tax Commission to enter into a licensing agreement of not more than \$20 per licenses plate.

Fiscal Analysis

From the Oklahoma Tax Commission:

Section 1 proposes to amend 47 O. S. § 1135.3 by striking the provision for the Jenks Trojans special license plate to reclassify it as a financial support special license plate in 47 O. S. § 1135.5.

Section 2 proposes to amend 47 O. S. § 1135.5 by changing the Emergency Medical Technician Death Benefit Revolving Fund to the Emergency Medical Personnel Death Benefit Revolving Fund. It also creates the Jenks Trojans and Bixby Spartans special license plates.

The annual fee for special license plates issued pursuant to the amended section is \$35 and is in addition to all other annual vehicle registration fees. Of this amount, \$20 shall be paid to the referenced School Districts pursuant to licensing agreements; \$8.00 shall be deposited in the OTC Reimbursement Fund to be used for administrative purposes associated with issuance of the special license plate and any remaining amounts of the \$35 fee are to be apportioned as motor vehicle collections pursuant to the provisions of 47 O.S. § 1104.

Any estimated revenue impact will be minimal (positive in nature). There is no estimated administrative impact associated with the proposed amendments.
