Research Analysis

The measure modifies the prohibition of declaring county property surplus during the election of a county commissioner. Currently, no property may be declared surplus beginning 30 days prior to the filing period for the election of any county commissioner until after the commissioner is sworn into office. The measure would modify this prohibition to two county commissioners, allowing a board of county commissioners to declare surplus property if only one of three commissioners is up for election.

Additionally, the measure authorizes the sale of property with tribal governments.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure relates to the circumstances related to the disposition of county surplus property during the election period for county commissioners. The provisions do not modify the actual surplus property process aside from the determination that property is surplus during election periods. No direct fiscal or revenue impact is anticipated.
