**Research Analysis**

The measure directs the State Bond Advisor in collaboration with the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to produce an affordability study to be presented to the Governor and the Legislature. The study would be used to determine Oklahoma's debt position.

The Senate Amendment to the House Bill clarified that the study will include agencies and state-beneficiary public trusts that are authorized to issue debt. The SAHB also changed the final report due date from December 15<sup>th</sup> to January 15<sup>th</sup> and restored title.
