Research Analysis

The Senate Amendment to HB 1540 allows person possessing a winemaker license to sell wine produced at the winery for either on-premises or off-premises consumption. The measure allows the holder of a winemaker license to sell and serve Oklahoma-manufactured wine, mulled wine, or spiced wine, mixed with nonalcoholic beverages or food items such as water, sugar, fruits and vegetables, at any temperature for either on-premises or off-premises consumption. The measure deletes the requirement that a person obtain a Direct Wine Consumer's Permit. The measure requires that holders of a Direct Wine Shipper's permit verify electronically or otherwise that the consumer is at least 21 years of age.
