HB 1597 allows a judgement creditor to issue a subpoena compelling disclosure of information by the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission which would otherwise be kept confidential.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Upon review of the measure, the Oklahoma Employment Securities Commission (OESC), a non-appropriated agency, estimates the fiscal impact to their agency would be estimated at \$200,000. The measure would require one additional attorney, including salary, benefits, travel costs, additional copying costs and mailing expenses.
