**Fiscal Analysis**

FA3 would drastically reduce the threshold for placing an initiative on statewide ballot, likely resulting in a significant increase in such ballot initiatives. Such an increase in initiatives will require the printing of additional ballot pages each election. The costs associated with each additional ballot page are approximately \$615,000 statewide, based on printing costs for the 2016 General Election.
