**Research Analysis**

The Senate amendments to HB 1607 provides that a child passenger being transported by a driver of a vehicle who has been issued a detachable placard indicating physical disability or a physically disabled license plate and valid letter of forward-facing exemption issued from the Department of Public Safety shall be permitted to restrain a child under four (4) years of age in a forward-facing child passenger restraint system. The placard and forward-facing exemption letter must be present in the vehicle to be in compliance.
