**Research Analysis**

The introduced measure will require through rule all medical and direct care staff of nursing and specialized facilities, adult day care centers, assisted living centers, home health agencies and licensed hospice agencies to complete at least one hour of inservice training per year in Alzheimer's and dementia related care. The measure also requires the promulgation of rules establishing appropriate training requirements for support staff that work in such facilities that do not provide direct care for patients.
