## **Research Analysis**

The SA modifies the language relating to the in-service training curricula for Alzheimer's and dementia-related care.

The bill directs the State Board of Health to promulgate rules that require all medical and direct care staff of nursing and specialized facilities, adult day care centers, assisted living centers, home health agencies and licensed hospice agencies to complete at least one hour of in-service training per year in Alzheimer's and dementia related care. It also requires the promulgation of rules establishing appropriate training requirements for support staff that work in such facilities that do not provide direct care for patients.
