**Research Analysis**

The bill requires school districts to notify teachers in writing if it intends to provide retirement benefits to a teacher such that their salary would be less than the amounts set forth in the minimum teacher salary schedule. New teachers must be notified prior to employment, and current teachers must be notified no later than 30 days prior to the date the district elects to provide retirements benefits that would lower the teacher's salary below the minimum salary schedule.

**Fiscal Analysis**

CS for HB 1622 relates to schools and provides that if a school district intends to provide retirement benefits to a teacher such that the teacher's salary would be less than the amounts in the minimum salary schedule, the district will be required to provide specified written notification to the teacher no later than 30 days prior to the date the district elects to provide the benefits as specified. The measure has no fiscal impact.
