**Research Analysis**

The measure clarifies the payment process for the removal or relocation of utility facilities. The measure states that facilities requiring relocation that are owned by another municipality having a population of at least 5,000 or a private utility company, the owner must provide funds to the state to match federal funds. If the utility has multiple owners, each owner is responsible for their portion of ownership.
